2. Determine the proportion of children in public and private schools.
3. Apply the proportions to the LEA's total Title I allocation to determine the equitable shares.

1. Enter the total allocation.
2. Calculate 1% of the LEA's total Title I allocation for public school PFE.
3. Apply the proportionate share to the public school PFE, which gives you the PFE of private schools.
4. This is taken from the funds allocated for all equitable services activities.
