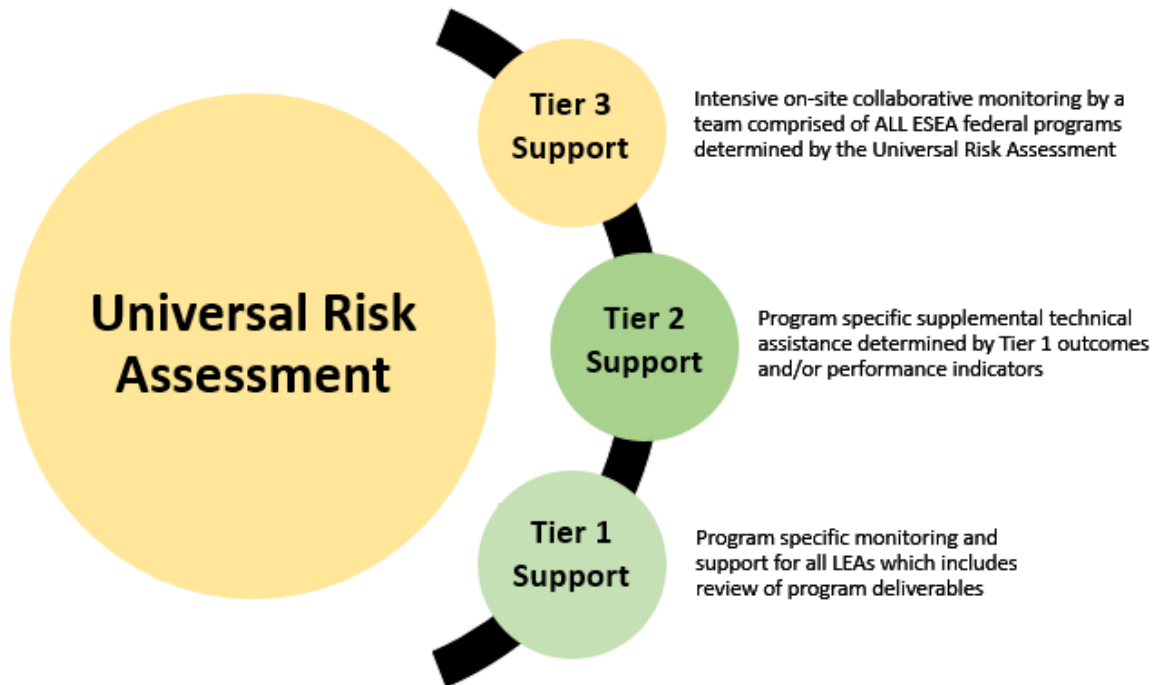


# Florida's Universal Monitoring System



FDOE's universal monitoring system is designed to identify the districts most in need of support and tiered to provide the most intensive support to LEAs most in need.

The consolidated application, monitoring, and technical assistance provided will be differentiated based on need and performance history. FDOE believes that, if we work collaboratively with districts, we can increase the effectiveness of ESEA programs which in turn would have a positive impact on student performance.

Tier 1 and Tier 2 monitoring will be carried out through a combination of program specific support and technical assistance opportunities. Tier 1 and Tier 2 monitoring begin during the application review process and provides an opportunity to support, collect and evaluate information provided by LEAs to show compliance with program requirements. Tier 1 support concentrates on deliverables and Tier 2 support is based on Tier 1 outcomes and/ or performance indicators.

Tier 3 intensive on-site collaborative monitoring is guided by a universal risk assessment. This level of monitoring will be conducted by a team comprised of ALL ESEA federal programs.
