# The Instructional Support Personnel Scholarship

- Qualifications:
  - Employed at a Florida public Title I school in an instructional support role (e.g., paraprofessional, teacher's aide, etc.), or in an instructional support role that is funded by a federal program (e.g., migrant advocate, etc.)
  - Completed an Associates of Arts degree (A.A.) or a minimum of 60 hours of college credits
  - Currently enrolled in a post-secondary institution and majoring in Education
- \$1,500 award
- Awarded to 2 recipients in each of the 5 FASFEP regions
