Title I, Part A Program Updates

Title I, Part A Revised 2017-2018 Allocation

FY 2017-2018 Title I, Part A allocation

- **0.6791** percent across-the-board reduction
- \$852,318,745.00 (Florida's revised final)
- **-\$4,704,944.00 (difference)**
 - **Revised amounts will be reflected in the online application**
 - **Make adjustments in the online budget before "submitting" the application**

Application Reviews

- **Section 1112-Local Educational Agencies (LEA) may receive a subgrant ...IF the LEA has on file with the State Educational Agency an **approved** plan**
- **Due date-August 25, 2017**
- Application reviews are underway
- Changes unrelated to Department feedback can be made when your regional team opens your application for editing

Application Reviews Tips

The quickest way to get to a signed DOE 200...

- Ask for clarification
- Complete all sections of the application
- Make requested changes timely
- Return changes timely (3-5 days)
 - Communicate delays to regional team or Title I Director
- Reduce administrative costs to eight percent or less

Application Reviews Tips, cont.

- Public School Eligibility Survey **MUST** reflect schools in rank order
- National School Lunch data can account for small enrollment changes
- Address noted data discrepancies fully
- Give priority to high-need schools when allocating the parent and family engagement reservation
 - Expect feedback/questions in this area

Data and Survey Reporting

Surveys you need to know...

Program Uses

- **Survey 2-October**
 - Used for PSES “K” Codes Revisions and PSES amendments
- **Survey 3- February**
 - Used to populate the PSES for the next school year
- **Survey 5-August**
 - Title I, Parts A, C, IX, and D use data from this survey
 - Used to report set-aside amounts, parent and family engagement amounts, School Program Types (SW or TA)
 - **TIPC funding**

Survey Reporting Update

- Due to recent hurricane activities, Survey 5 reporting dates were modified
 - October 20, 2017 (target date)
 - October 27, 2017 (data used for reporting)

Title I, Part C Program Updates

Comprehensive Needs Assessment Committee

- Needs Assessment Committee Meeting in Tallahassee, Florida on November 7, 2017
- Plan services in major areas of the Service Delivery Plan (English Language Arts, Mathematics, Graduation, Early Childhood, Out-of-School Youth and Health)

Title I, Part C Application Review Tips

The quickest way to get to a signed DOE 200...

- Ask for clarification
- Complete all sections of the application
- Make requested changes timely
- Return changes timely (3-5 days)
 - Communicate delays Migrant Education Program staff

Identification and Recruitment Reminder

- Complete re-interviews on a randomly selected sample from the 2016-17 school year
- Districts must submit completed re-interview forms to the ID&R Office
- Contact the ID&R Team for assistance

Title I, Part D

Title I, Part D Annual Counts-Survey 9

- Residential Counts are included in the allocation calculation to states for funding
- LEAs should select 30-day window to count students who reside in Neglected or Delinquent Residential facilities for at least one day
 - Count windows must be a time period of 30 consecutive days with at least one day in the month of October
 - Can begin as early as September 2 and end as late as November 29

The impact of recent hurricanes

- Count windows should be selected in a manner that is advantageous for the LEA
- LEAs who evacuated students because of the storm should select count windows before students were evacuated or after they returned to their residing LEA

2017 Monitoring

Monitoring Timelines (subject to change)

- ~~July Mid-September~~ Workpaper revisions to align to ESSA Requirements
- **Late November to Early January**-Workpapers available to districts
- Monitoring designations and monitoring weeks are TBD at this time
