1. All immigrants under Title III are English language learners.
2. Students born in Puerto Rico may qualify as immigrants under Title III.
3. Students born in a United States territory may qualify as immigrants under Title III.
4. Students born to United States military personnel may qualify as immigrants under Title III.
5. Students born outside the United States and adopted by United States citizens may qualify as immigrants under Title III.
6. LEAs qualify for Title III immigrant funds based solely on their total number of immigrants.
7. A student may qualify as an immigrant under Title III for more than 3 years.
8. States may designate up to one-third of their Title III funds as immigrant funds to qualifying LEAs.
