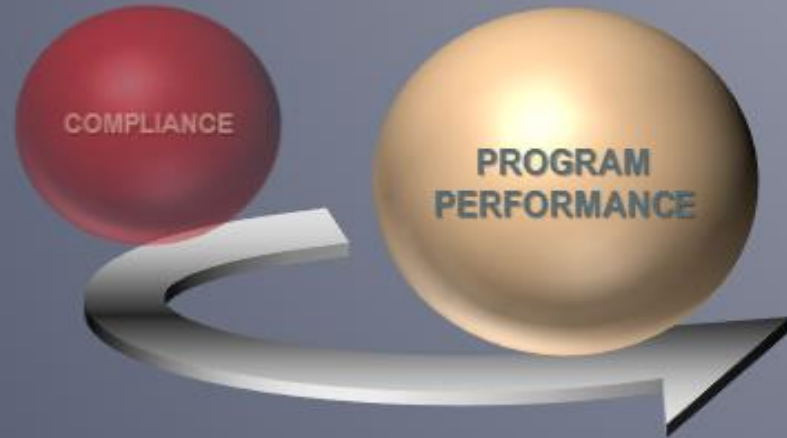

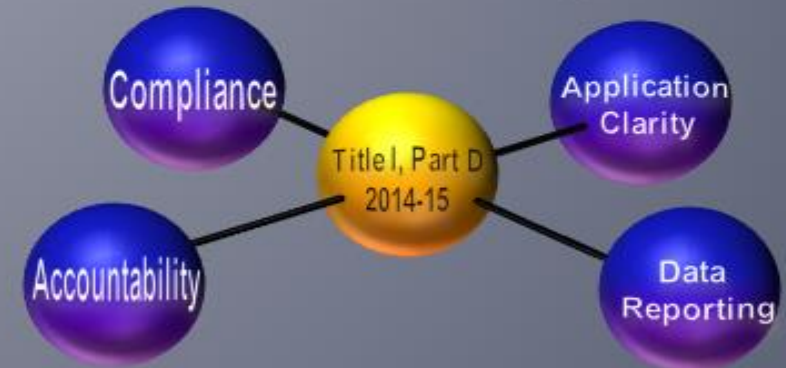

Generation of funding is **not** the only requirement for eligibility for Title I, Part D

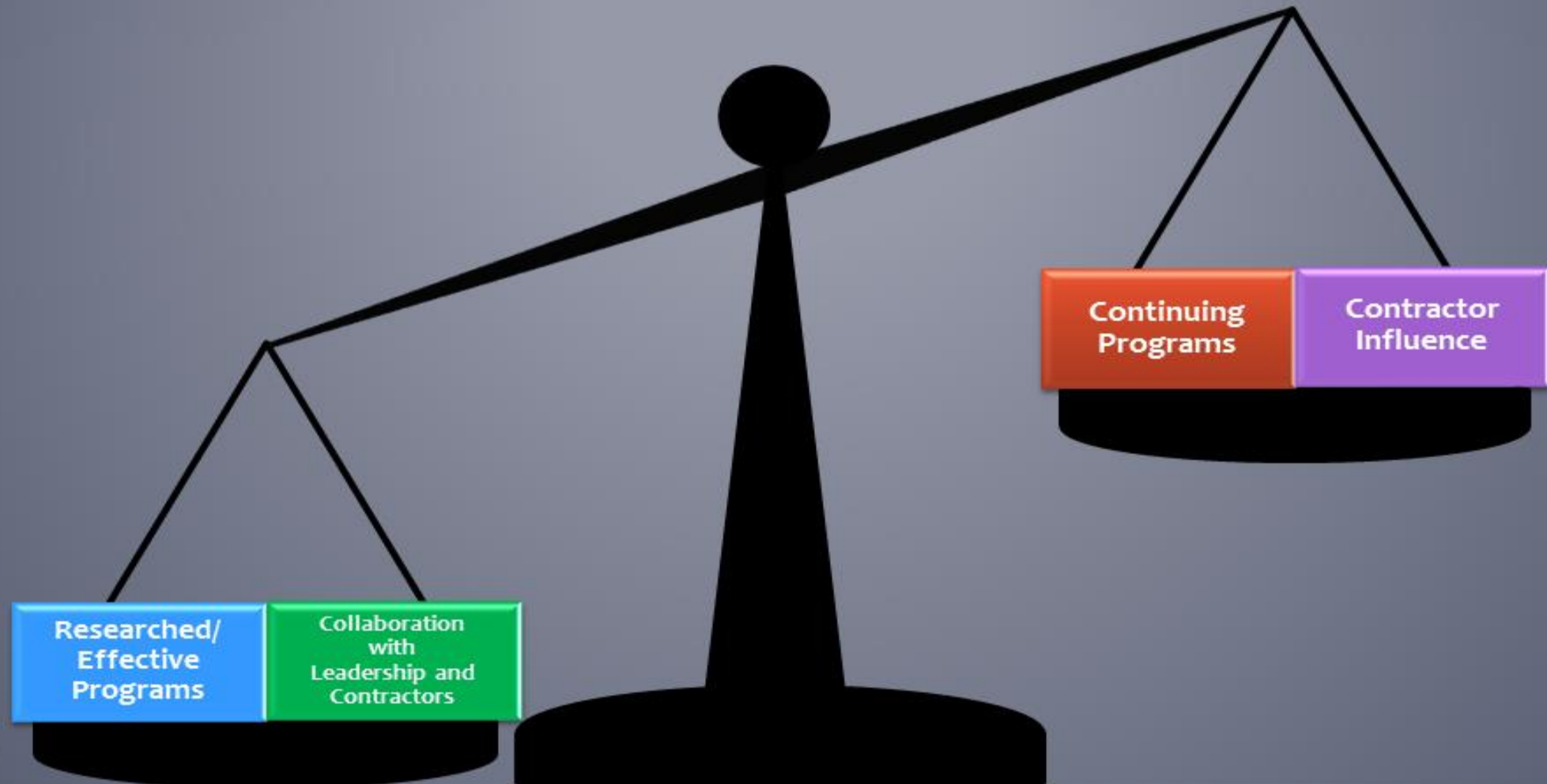
All Neglected, Delinquent and At-risk students are eligible

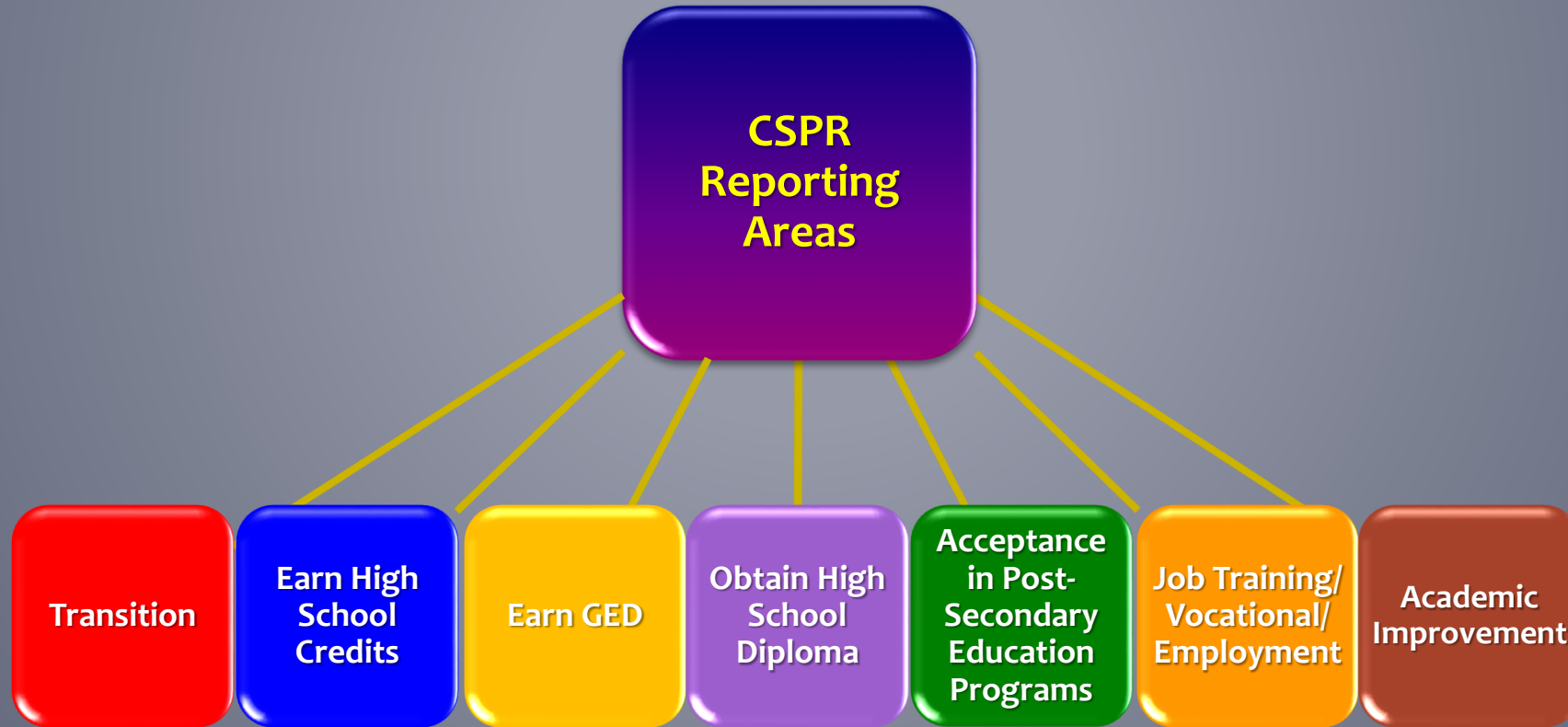

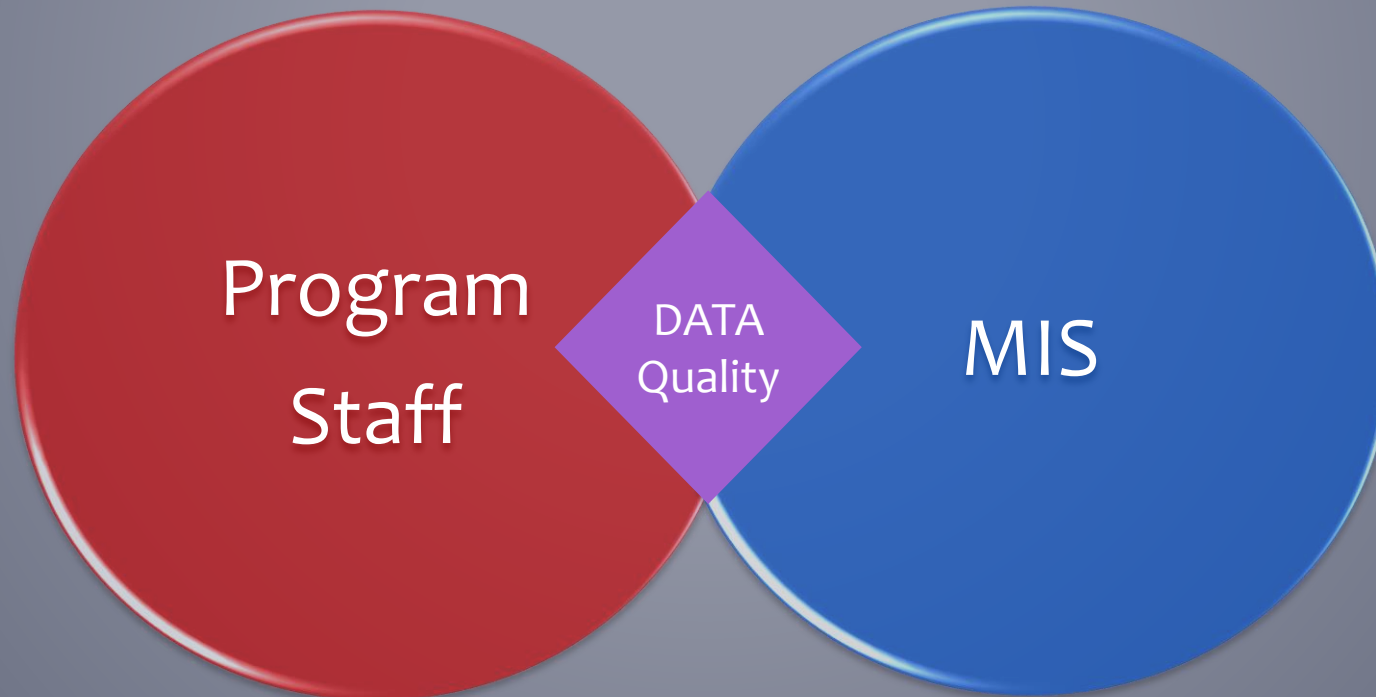

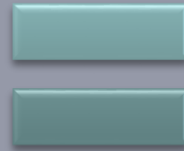

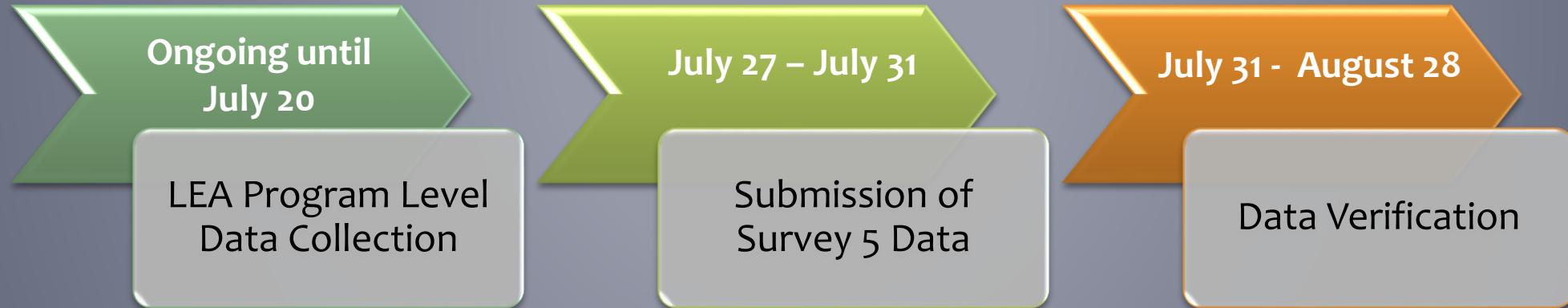
