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Title I, Part A

- **Program Overview:** The purpose of Title I, Part A funds is to provide additional resources and services to economically disadvantaged students.
- **Data Utilized for Funding Purposes:**
 - Survey 2, Survey 3 and Survey 5
 - Public School Eligibility Survey
- **Program Updates:**
 - USED Allocation Increase
 - Project Amendments

Title I, Part C

- **Program Overview:** The purpose of the Title I, Part C Florida Migrant Education Program (FMEP) is to ensure high-quality education programs and supplemental support services are available to migratory children.
- **Data Utilized for Funding Purposes:**
 - FDOE Survey 5 for LEA allocations
 - Federal performance reporting
 - Annual Program Evaluation
- **Program Updates:**
 - Migrant Student Information Exchange (MSIX) child counts will be used for state-level Title I, Part C funding allocations.

Title IV, Part A

- **Program Overview:** The purpose of the Title IV, Part A program is to improve student academic achievement through work in well-rounded education, safe and healthy learning conditions, and effective use of technology.
- **Data Utilized for Funding Purposes:**
 - Same proportion as the LEA's prior year's Title I, Part A allocation.
- **Program Updates:**
 - The Bipartisan Safe Communities Act may result in additional Title IV, Part A funds in the area of safe and healthy learning conditions.
 - The Title IV, Part A program reports the amount LEAs expend in each area of focus to USED in February.

Title V

- **Program Overview:** The purpose of the Rural and Low-Income School (RLIS) program is to provide rural districts with financial assistance for initiatives aimed at improving student achievement.
- **Data Utilized for Funding Purposes:**
 - FDOE Survey 5 to determine LEA allocations
 - Eligibility for the RLIS program is determined by USED using census data from the Small Area Income and Poverty Estimates (SAIPE) program
- **Program Updates:**
 - The program office will submit attendance data to USED in December to help determine the state allocation for 2023-34.
 - SAIPE data will also be available in December to help the program office determine preliminary eligibility for 2024-25.

Title IX, Part A

- **Program Overview:** The purpose of Title IX, Part A Program is to ensure each homeless child and youth has equal access to the same free, appropriate public education, including a public preschool education, as other children and youth, through the facilitation of enrollment, attendance, and success in school.
- **Data Utilized for Funding Purposes:**
 - FDOE Survey 3 and Survey 5 for LEA allocations
- **Program Updates:**
 - 2021-22 Education of Homeless Children and Youth (EHCY) End of Year Reports are due October 7, 2022.
 - Regional navigator projects have been approved by FDOE and are starting implementation.
